



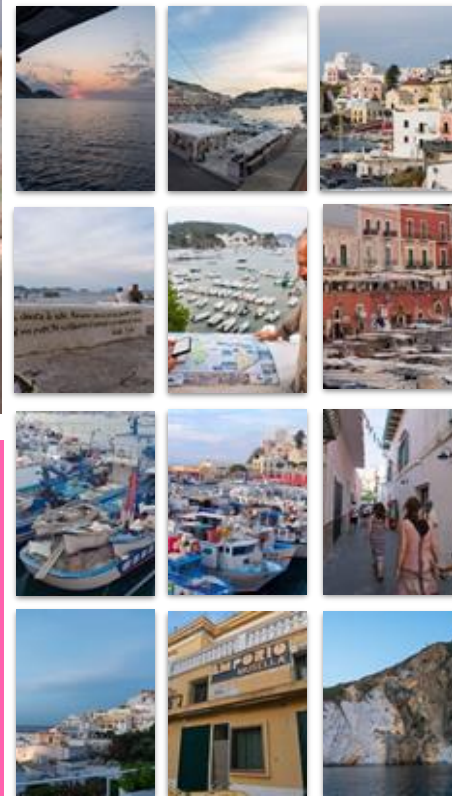
Ponza Island -

Ponza is a unique Mediterranean island facing growing environmental and social challenges mainly caused by unsustainable mass tourism. Traditional fishing communities have almost disappeared, and the historic anchovy fishery is no longer part of the island's daily life.
